The first few weeks of school are a great opportunity to set some goals for the year as it pertains to securing an internship for next summer or full-time employment upon graduation. **↓ THIS IS IMPORTANT! ↓**

Many employers will secure their Summer 2018 interns and May 2018 graduates this semester, so it is in your best interest to get your search started ASAP.

There are also many components to a successful job search from creating a great resume to navigating the interview process. You can get started at the Engineering Career Center website which includes a Career Resources Toolbox.

The best way to increase your odds of landing an internship next summer or job at graduation is to set short, specific and measurable goals in order to hold yourself accountable for reaching your ultimate goal.

Here are examples of good goals to set:

- Apply to at least 20 jobs by the end of September.
- Reach out to at least 20 people from my network regarding job opportunities.
- Follow up with at least 15 employers from the 20+ jobs I applied to by October 5th.
- Secure at least 5 interviews this semester.
- Secure a job offer by Winter Break.
