In order to help you get prepared for the next employer info session that you attend, here are some tips that you can apply to ensure you are making the most out of the session that could potentially land you a job!

Before

- Research and follow the company on LinkedIn
- Apply for jobs that employer posted on UIC careers if it connects to your major and interest
- Prepare your elevator pitch & review your resume (Attend one of our [resume review sessions](#))
- Prepare questions to ask about their company

During

- Try to arrive early to get a seat toward the front
- Dress code: casual to business casual. Employers know that you are coming from class
- Take notes and ask prepared questions

After

- Introduce yourself to the employer and give your elevator pitch along with your resume
- Thank them for their time and ask for their business card
- Follow up with them and add them to your networking circle!
